What we know about COVID-19 booster shots

Information related to booster doses of the COVID-19 vaccine is changing rapidly. The Center for Disease Control (CDC) Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) released a statement September 24, 2021 recommending a booster shot for the Pfizer-BioNTech's COVID-19 vaccine (Pfizer) for the elderly, those in long-term care facilities, people with underlying medical conditions, and for adults with high risk of disease from occupational and institutional exposures to COVID-19.
