POLICY STATEMENT

The policy of Island Hospital is to provide a sustainable transportation option for patients, visitors and staff as we continue to help reduce greenhouse gas emissions and improve air quality.

PURPOSE

Provide cutting-edge, clean transportation technologies to patients, visitors, and employees.

SCOPE

All employees

- EV – Electric Vehicle

EQUIPMENT

- Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

QUALITY CONTROL

This policy will be reviewed on an annual basis.

GUIDELINES:

1. There are currently two single station EV charging stations installed on the Island Hospital campus. One is located in the lower level parking lot of the Medical Office Building (MOB), the other is in the Employee Parking Lot on 26th Street. (A 3rd will be installed in the Medical Arts Pavilion (MAP) parking lot in the near future).
2. The charging stations are available for employees, patients and visitors to charge their electric powered vehicles.
3. Users must have a SemaConnect card and will be charged a \$1.70/hr for use of the station.
4. Each station will have a designated parking stall which will be clearly marked with signage and green pavement markings.
5. Per [RCW 46.08.185](#) it is a parking infraction of \$124 for any person to park a vehicle in an EV charging station while not connected to the charging equipment.
6. Hospital staff, when seeing a violation, should report this to Administration. Administration will be responsible for enforcing the RCW statute during regular business hours and the security guard will be responsible after hours and on weekends.
7. Island Hospital will not be liable for any damages arising out of the malfunction, use, or inability to use this Charging Station.
