Charles provided an update on the ongoing COVID 19 pandemic within our region and highlighted the following:

Elise provided a review of the daily revenue volumes for 2020 and remarked on the Federal Funding Bill initiatives that would potentially may assist Island Hospital.

Elise shared that there has been a temporary modification of the Island Hospital Financial Assistance Policy and statement timelines in response to possible income disruptions during the pandemic.

Commissioner Tessler made a motion to support the Administrative strategy to respond to the COVID 19 pandemic:

In recognition of the COVID-19 pandemic spread through our region and into our community, Island Hospital leadership is supported with the actions taken to reduce patient care services and cancel elective procedures. In working to protect our healthcare system's ability to provide care both now and in the future, both operational and labor cost reductions are needed. These significant measures are designed to protect our patients, providers, staff and our community and are necessary to keep Island Hospital viable during and after this threat.

The Board of Commissioners understand the difficulties in the process of reducing hospital and clinic services and the impact that it has on both our staff and our community. Together with the hospital leadership team, we will do all that we can to meet the needs of this crisis and restandup our services when the COVID 19 threat passes.

We want each of you to know how grateful we are for the courageous and compassionate healthcare you are delivering to our community. We are all in this fight together, but you are truly the heart and soul of our healthcare system.

Commissioners Lang, Iversen, Bogosian and Maughan seconded the motion. Commissioners Bogosian, Iversen, Lang, Tessler and Maughan all voted aye and the motion carried.
